### **Assessment Guidelines**

- examination/training center (as per assessment criteria below)
- 4. Individual assessment agencies will create unique evaluations for skill practical for every student at each
- examination/training center based on this criteria
- 5. To pass the Qualification Pack, every trainee should score as per assessment grid.
- 6. In case of successfully passing only certain number of NOS's the trainee is eligible to take subsequent assessment on the balance NOS's to pass the Qualification Pack
