


31st HSSC Governing Council meeting & 13th AGM

Launch of HSSC Accreditation Standards for Home Care, Residential Care, Healthcare Simulation, and Ambulance Service Providers

HSSC has successfully hosted the launch event of its Accreditation Standards for four critical areas of healthcare delivery – Home Care Service Providers, Residential Care Facilities, Healthcare Simulation Centers, and Ambulance Service Providers.

The event was attended by over 100 industry partners, including representatives from leading healthcare organizations, training institutions, and regulatory bodies, reflecting the strong support from the sector.

HSSC Accreditation Board and Technical Committee played a key role in shaping the HSSC Accreditation Framework. The Board guided policy and strategic direction, developing comprehensive policies for accreditation processes, assessment methodologies, and quality improvement across healthcare domains whereas the technical committee, comprising expert professionals, provided the scientific and methodological foundation, developing evidence-based standards and introducing standardized assessment protocols and outcome measurement frameworks. Together, they ensured the accreditation system is consistent, transparent, and aligned with national priorities and international best practices.

Speaking at the event, HSSC leadership emphasized that these accreditation standards are designed to ensure service quality, patient safety, and workforce competency, while promoting standardization and accountability. This initiative is a significant step towards strengthening healthcare delivery and building a skilled and trusted healthcare ecosystem in India.

HSSC's Participation in NCERT Workshop on Integrating Healthcare **Modules under NISHTHA**


The Healthcare Sector Skill Council (HSSC) was invited to a two-day workshop organized by the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) to explore the inclusion of Healthcare and Life-saving modules under the Government of India's flagship initiative - National Initiative for School Heads' and Teachers' Holistic Advancement (NISHTHA).

The workshop was chaired by Prof. Ranjana Arora, Head, Department of Curriculum Studies & Development (DCS&D), NIE, NCERT.

During the deliberations, HSSC's micro-credential courses on First Aid Care, CPR, Basic Cardio-Pulmonary Life Support (BCLS), Infection Control and Sanitization Measures, and Elderly Care were selected for integration into the credit-based Continuous Professional Development (CPD) framework for school heads and teachers.

This collaboration marks a significant step towards building a culture of health awareness and life-saving preparedness among educators across the country.

This event represents a significant milestone in HSSC's ongoing mission to standardise, formalize, and promote excellence in AYUSH skill development.


















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
