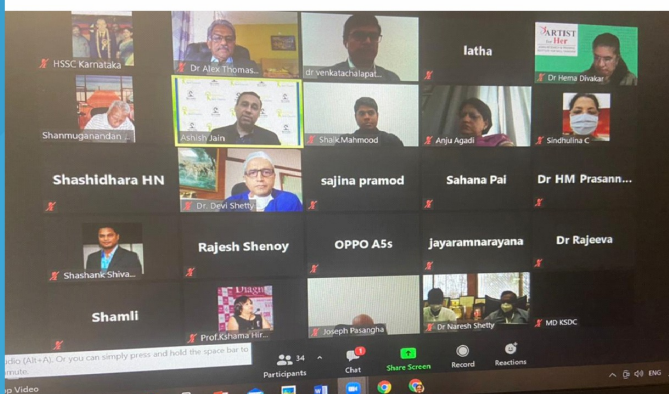
## Meetings

- **World Bank COVID Project:** Advisory Committee meeting under chairmanship of Dr. Devi Shetty held on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2020 and technical committee was formulated under chairpersonship of **Dr Shubnum Singh** with nominations by advisory committee members from their respective organizations. The 1<sup>st</sup> technical committee meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2020.
- **Technical committee members** finalised the list of training needs arising in the healthcare sector during and post COVID 19. They have also further prioritized the training needs. The training list has also been categorised as per input criteria (technician, nurses, doctors).
- Meeting with selected experts from assessing bodies organized to discuss the formulation of assessment blueprint.
- **7<sup>th</sup> Expert Committee** meeting held on 18th March 2021 at 15:00 Hrs. via Video Conference, incorporating 5<sup>th</sup> project review and steering group (PRSG) for reviewing two Schemes of Meity on Skill Development in ESDM Sector viz. *“Scheme for Financial Assistance to Select States/UTs for Skill Development in Electronics System Design and Manufacturing (ESDM) Sector” (Scheme-1) & “Skill Development in ESDM for Digital India” (Scheme-2).*
- **HSSC-Assessor Guide meet** with selected experts from assessing bodies on March 3<sup>rd</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> 2021 to discuss the formulation of assessment blueprint for HSSC job roles.

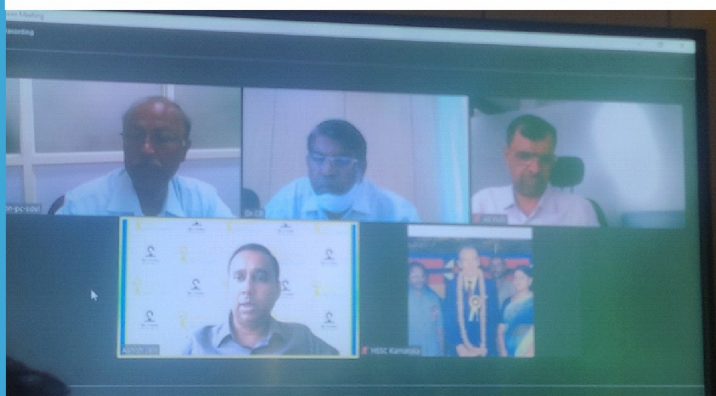
## State Activities

- 2. Fund:** Reduce risk by providing patient capital, including grants and equity.
- 3. Enable:** the creation and sustainability of support systems required for skill development. This includes the Industry led Sector Skill Councils.

The main objectives of the NSDC are to:

- Upgrade skills to international standards through significant industry involvement and develop necessary frameworks for standards, curriculum and quality assurance.
- Enhance, support and coordinate private sector Initiatives for skill development through appropriate Public-Private Partnership (PPP) models; strive for significant operational and financial involvement from the private sector.
- Play the role of a "market maker" by bringing financing, certified trainers and where market mechanisms are ineffective or missing.

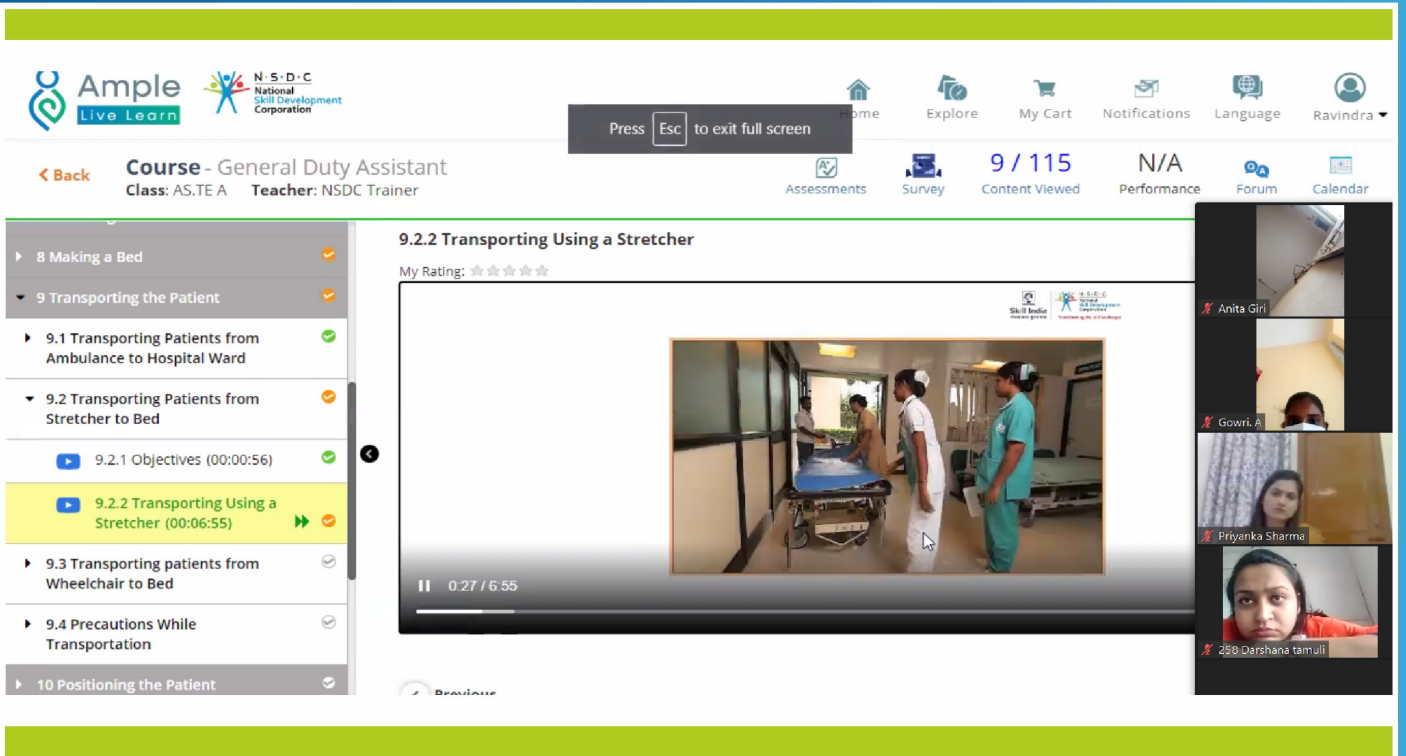
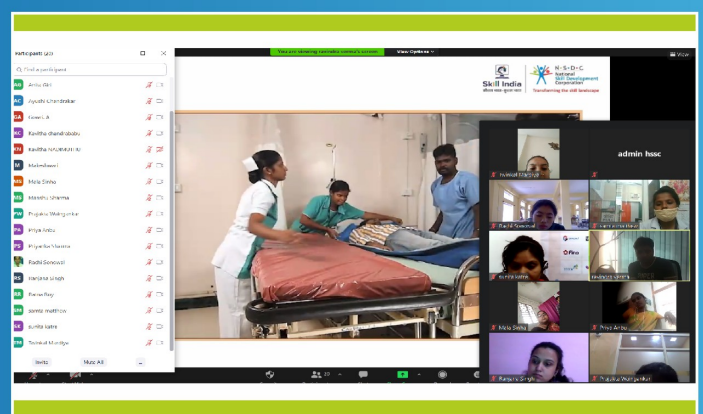
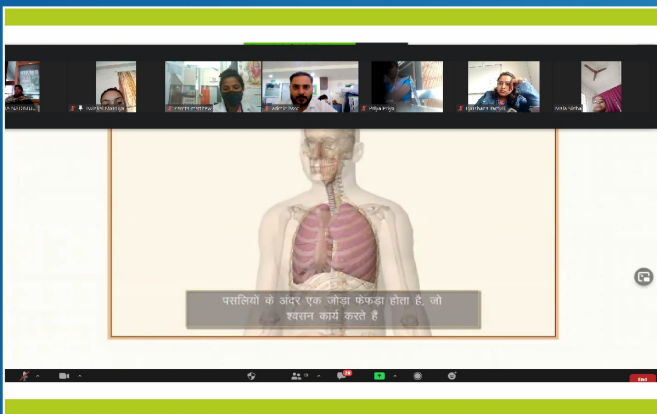
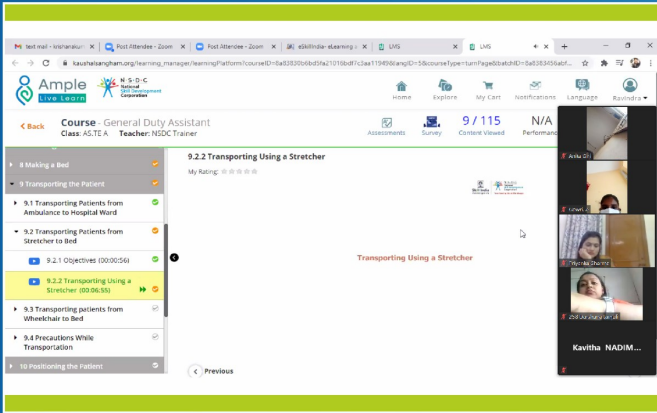
